Luna Beberide Godello 2018 (White Wine)



This family winery traces its history to 1986, predating the renaissance in Bierzo by about 10 years. The current winemaker, Alejandro Luna, is the second generation proprietor and focuses on traditional grapes for the area, Godello for white wines and Mencia for reds. They follow organic methods with no herbicide or pesticide use in the vineyards and allow native microbes to ferment the wines in the cellar.

Winemaking starts with all grapes being hand harvested into 18 kilo boxes. Careful cluster sorting, eliminating unsound bunches continues the push toward quality. All varietals are fermented separately with native yeasts prior to aging in oak barrels.

"There are a bunch of wines from 2018 already bottled, among which was the 2018 Godello from Luna Beberide. Such recent bottling tends to be harsh for whites, which tend to show reductive and reminiscent of sulfur, so you often have to guide yourself by the palate, which revealed a wine that follows the path of freshness of 2016, with clean flavors and citrus freshness. Give it a few more months in bottle. 50,000 bottles produced. It was bottled in December 2018. Drink Date 2019 – 2021."
