“ The 2015 version is excellent, offering up a deep and more black fruity bouquet of black cherries, raspberries, grilled meats, a touch of coffee bean, garrigue, stony soil tones and a topnote of bonfire. On the palate the wine is full-bodied, bright and shows off even better midpalate depth from the older vines. The wine is nicely balanced, ripely tannic and focused, with good backend soil signature and a nascently complex finish. The extra element of fruit from the old vines covers the tannins a bit better out of the blocks than in the regular bottling, and consequently, this is a bit more approachable out of the blocks (though still really built for a bit of cellaring). Fine juice and another stellar value, as this cuvée is all of fourteen dollars here in America! 2017-2035.”

“ Brilliant ruby-red. Aromas of ripe red berries, cherry and lavender take on a smoky topnote as the wine opens up. Silky and alluringly sweet, offering black raspberry, cherry liqueur and floral pastille flavors enlivened by a jolt of white pepper. The long, fruit-driven finish shows very good clarity, silky tannins and an echo of juicy red fruit. 2018 - 2022”
