**2015** was a year of little rainfall, without significant frosts. Sprouting arrived late, slow and uneven. Harvesting began on 4th of September, with low yields, due to an advanced cycle that began in the spring and to ease the effects of the water deficit in the vineyards most affected. A remarkable vintage with a warmer profile, compensated by a fresher end to Summer than usual and high contrasts in temperatures between night and day.

Expressive and succulent with red fruit in abundance. Gracious texture with melted tannins. Concentration without the excess.
