

Winery: Bodegas Abanico began in the autumn of 2006 when Rafael de Haan and Nuria Altes decided to make their own wine in Celler Batea, Terra Alta.

Since 2006 Rafael and Nuria have developed numerous brands from all over Spain and continue to search out great wines, regions and projects to add to their range. Today, they are confident that every wine justifies its place in their portfolio and represents true quality, regional authenticity, varietal character, as well as great value.

Wine: Produced from Sauvignon Blanc vines averaging 12 years old. The vines are grown in sandy loam in central southern Spain. The climate there is continental with Mediterranean influence; a cold winter is followed by hot summer days and warm summer nights. Long, slow fermentation took place in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks to maintain bright, fresh fruit aromas in the finished wine.

"Bright straw. A lively, focused bouquet evokes lemon zest, green apple and white flowers, with a subtle herbal quality in the background. Silky and smooth in texture, offering straightforward citrus and orchard fruit flavors and a refreshingly bitter note of quinine. Finishes firm and a bit edgy, with good spicy persistence."
